# 1) How do you see God?

GEN 3:1-4 - The serpent was the shrewdest of all the wild animals the LORD God had made. One day he asked the woman, "Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?" "Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden," the woman replied. "It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we are not allowed to eat. God said, 'You must not eat it or even touch it; if you do, you will die." You won't die!" the serpent replied to the woman.

To accept someone or a concept you need to know it and understand it and our knowledge will lead us to trust or disbelief. Your perception of God is related with the knowledge you have of Him. And this is why it is important to know him more. notes:

# 2) Why was Jesus condemned to death?

JOHN 16:1 - But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. (NIV)

JOHN 8:38-44 - I am telling you what I have seen in the Father's presence, and you do what you have heard from your father." Abraham is our father," they answered. "If you were Abraham's children," said Jesus, "then you would do the things Abraham did. As it is, you are determined to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. Abraham did not do such things. You are doing the things your own father does." "We are not illegitimate children," they protested. "The only Father we have is God himself."

JOHN 3:8 - The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

I JOHN 4:8 - God is love, and anyone who doesn't love others has never known him. (CEV)

ISAIAH 6:8 - Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" (NIV)

1 Corinthians 13 - Love never fails.

MATTHEW 5:43-48 - "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? And if you greet only your brothers, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

GENESIS 1:26-27 - Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground." (NIV)

JOHN 10:10 - The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life. (NLT)

Love loves without question and all of us crave it. When we experience pleasure we want to share it and as love continues and expresses itself it deepens. Love is other centeredness, and we were created to experience and the pleasure of loving and being loved. This is what we were made for.
